Day 6: Florence

Called the "Pearl of the Lake," the village of Bellagio is characterized by century-old buildings, stone lanes and picturesque cobbled stairways filled with shops showcasing the finest Italian wares. Upon arrival, an orientation tour is followed by free time to stroll the Borgo, Bellagio's historic center, or enjoy lunch at an outdoor café. For longer walks, you may opt to visit the botanical gardens of Villa Melzi or explore the peaceful fishing hamlet of Pescallo or take in the breathtaking views of the lake and surrounding mountains from Punta Spartivento. Mid-afternoon, cruise back to Como passing quiet bays and elegant villas. This evening,
